

## UFOs captured on Google Street View hovering over East End bookies

A group of UFOs has been photographed hovering over London by Google Street View.

service was launched.

There were claims that a mystery figure in a black hat with a long scarf in a scene from Cardiff could be a Victorian ghost.

Meanwhile a blurry image bearing a distinct resemblance to ET, the film alien, was picked up by Google cameras near the town of Berkeley Heights in New Jersey, USA.

The figure, with a long neck and an oblong head appears next to a bright beam of light.

Residents of Wolverley Street were perplexed by the sighting.

A spokesman for Google said that a series of strange "blobs" had been reported since the service was first offered in Britain earlier this month.

"For us it just shows how Street View is an interesting tool for users," he said.

The UK version of Street View, which accompanies Google's mapping service and satellite imagery provides photographs of 22,360 miles of roads across 25 cities around the country.
